By-Law 27-2007

Responsibility of Owners Regarding Dogs

8(1) No owner shall:

- (a) permit his dog to run at large. When a dog is found running at large, its owner shall be deemed to have failed or refused to comply with this subsection.
- (b) permit his dog to bark or howl or in any other way unduly disturb the quiet of any person or persons anywhere in the City.
- (c) permit his dog to defecate on any public or private property other than the property of its owner. Where a dog defecates on property other than the property of its owner, the owner shall cause such excrement to be removed forthwith.
- (d) permit his dog to defecate on his property in a manner which constitutes an environmental or health hazard or a nuisance for
- (e) permit his dog to damage public property or private property other than that of the owner. Where public or private property has been damaged by a dog, its owner shall be deemed to have failed or refused to comply with this subsection.
- (f) own, keep, harbor or have possession or control of any dog (other than a dog that is under the age of four months or that is a registered guide dog for the visually impaired) for which a valid license has not been issued.
- (g) own, keep, harbor or have possession or control of any dog determined to be a dangerous animal.
- (h) permit his dog to pursue, bite, wound or worry any person or animal, whether or not on the property of the owner.
- (i) permit his dog on any school ground or playground.
- (j) permit his dog on public property (including parkland area) unless the dog is on a leash (which lease shall be no longer than six (6) feet in length, fully extended) and the dog is in the actual custody and effective control of the owner or a person competent to control it, unless the said public property has been specifically designated by Council as land upon which dogs are not required to be on a leash.
- (k) permit his dog to upset waste receptacles or otherwise litter.

- g) Noise Nuisance - means any unreasonably loud or unusual sound or any sounds which are likely to, or annoy, injure, or disturb the health, peace, or safety of any person.
 - h) Sound - means an oscillation in pressure, particle displacement, particle velocity or other physical parameter, in a medium with internal forces that causes compression and rarefaction of that medium. The description of sound may include any characteristic of such sound, including duration, intensity and frequency.
3. THAT except to the extent permitted by this By-law, no person shall make, continue, or cause to be made or continued, any noise nuisance, and specifically the following acts, among others, and the causing thereof, are declared to be in violation of this By-law, namely:
- (a) No person owning or possessing or harbouring any animal or bird shall allow it to create a noise nuisance.

You have been issued a numbered dog licence tag which will be your dog's licence number for the length of the dog's life in Morden. If you move or sell/give away the licensed dog, please notify the Morden Civic Centre Office at 204-822-4434 so we can update the file information. Also, if you lose this dog tag, please come to the Civic Centre to replace the licence for only \$5.00. Thank you!
