Request for Expressions of Interest

The City of Morden intends to construct a detention pond on the east side of Pembina Connection, in Morden. The project will result in approximately 20,000 cubic meters of fill that the City does not have a use for. We request that any interested parties submit a brief expression of interest (EOI) outlining the value of this material to you, following review of those received the City will enter into a contract on negotiated terms with the party that proposes to provide the best value to the City.

Project Description

The removal of approximately 20,000 cubic meters of fill material, to the rough grade of the detention pond. The City will direct the excavation, finished landscaping to be complete under separate contract.

Expectations of EOI

Please identify:

1. Yourself, company, or entity who the City will continue negotiations with;
2. The volume of material that you have interest in;
3. Cash value to you of the material per cubic meter or cubic yard, if any;
4. If no cash value, specify any in-kind value that you would provide (equipment, labour, etc.);
5. Your time frame for removal or delivery of the material;
6. The location of delivery if you do not intend to haul yourself;
7. Conditions of your expression of interest;
8. Any other information that you wish to provide;
9. Format of your EOI can be a brief letter.

The City intends to complete the detention pond construction in 2015; however, we are not under pressure to complete it by a particular date.
