

**CITY OF MORDEN**

**By-law No. 14-2012**

**BEING** a By-law of the City of Morden to establish the size of its police board.

**WHEREAS** Section 30(1) of “The Police Services Act”, SM 2009, c. 32 provides that:

“The council of a municipality must establish the size of its police board by by-law. The police board must  
(a) consist of at least three members, in the case of a municipality with a population of 5,000 or less;  
(b) consist of at least five members, in the case of a municipality with a population over 5,000; or  
(c) consist of at least seven members, in the case of the City of Winnipeg.”

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Morden in open session duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the size of the police board for the City of Morden shall be five members.

**DONE AND PASSED** by The Council of the City of Morden, assembled at the City of Morden, in the Province of Manitoba, this 13th day of November, A.D. 2012.
